SaskWater serves 77 communities, 11 rural municipalities, 78 rural pipeline groups, 15 industrial, and 261 commercial and domestic customers, reaching approximately 120,400 people. It owns nine water treatment plants, three wastewater facilities, and extensive pipelines and booster stations. Committed to excellent customer support, diverse services, innovation, and strong leadership, SaskWater aims to support economic growth and build sustainable communities in Saskatchewan.

The President and CEO of SaskWater provides strategic leadership, governance, and management to ensure the delivery of safe, reliable, and sustainable water and wastewater services in Saskatchewan.
